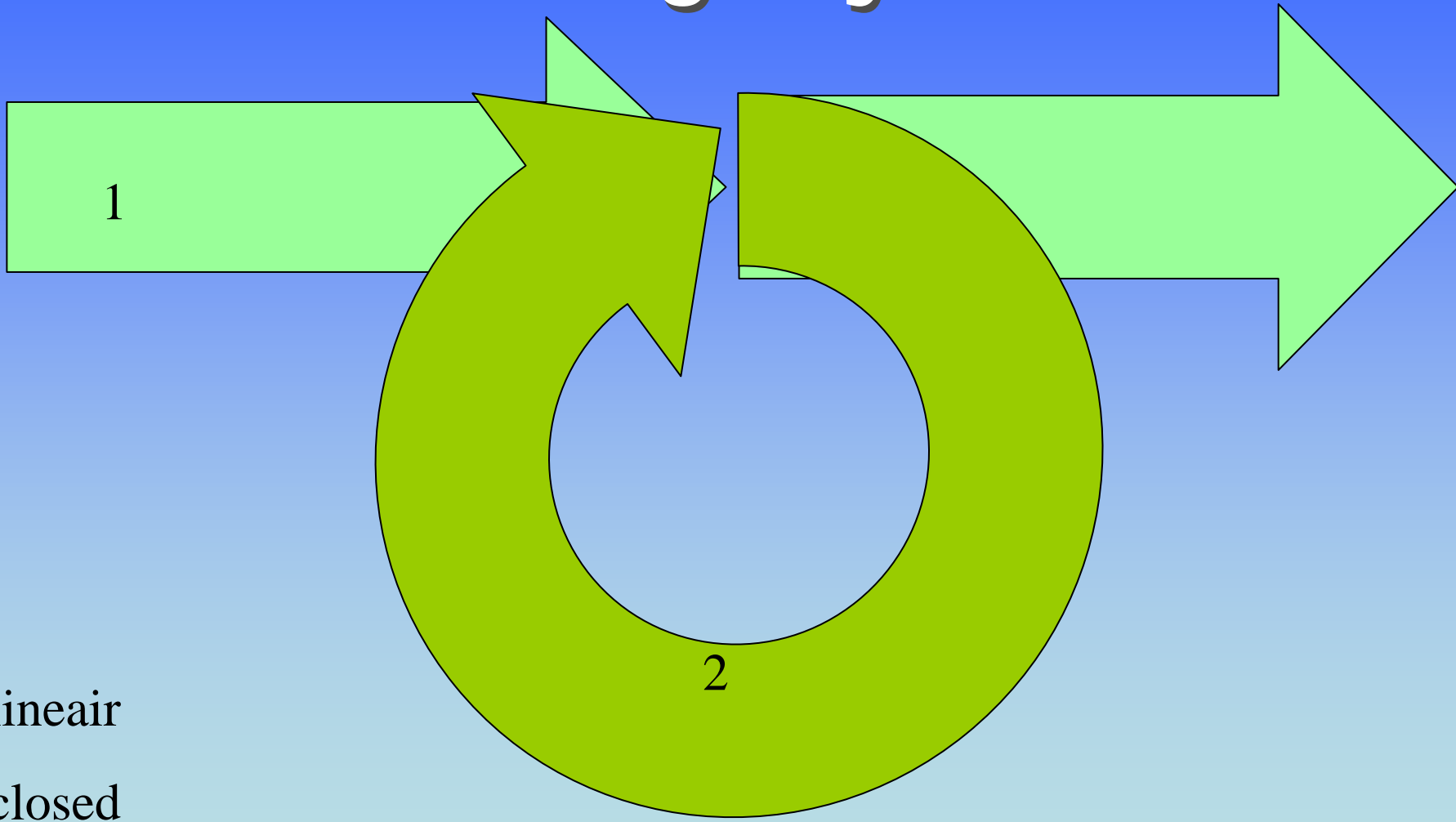

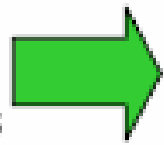

# Banyan tree

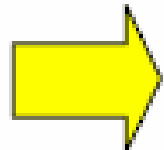

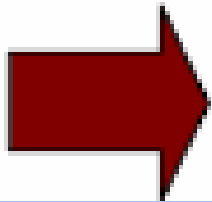
# Urban
